

SAFETY ISSUE

Please don't park in the emergency Ambulance Bay outside Blair Wark VC Community Centre when you are dropping off or picking up your children. This is marked as NO PARKING at any time for very obvious and important reasons.

In addition, the crosswalk for students to access the school is located right behind the emergency bay, meaning illegally parked cars are reversing straight onto a busy crosswalk where lots of students are crossing. It is also a blind corner from Dunstan Grove creating a very hazardous situation.

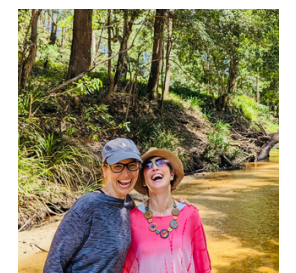
