LLV have launched a carpool website to encourage students to car share to and from the school. The purpose of the carpool website is to create LLV connections that may not currently be known to improve your travel options. Parents will be matched with other families based on their home address and days available to car share.

Did you know carpooling two return trips to/from LLV on average could save 2.24L of fuel, prevent 5.16kg of CO2 being produced and save \$3.94 in costs?

Parents and carers can create a membership on behalf of students by selecting from two different year groups:

- 3-6 Hub students
- 7-12 students

"In relation to the school's feedback, we acknowledge parent feedback regarding the bus issues to LLV and are actively looking for a solution for LLV.

However, this will require the procurement of additional bus fleet to implement any service improvements straight away. We have already commenced discussions with the new bus operator, who will take over Region 12 operations in the next couple of months, and Transport and the new operator (CDC) have committed to improving services to LLV."

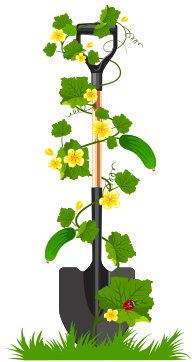

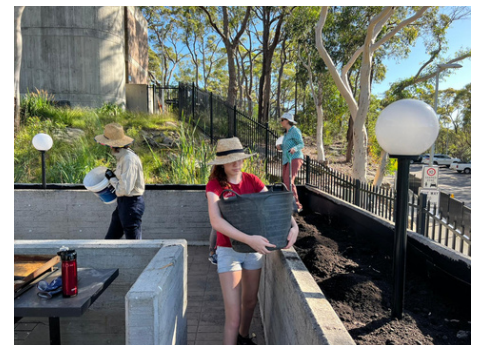
Kitchen Garden Working Bee
