

WAYS YOU CAN HELP MANAGE YOUR NEGATIVE IMPACT ON NATIVE FAUNA

ARE YOU A PET OWNER?



CATS

Get your cat a cat-friendly bell to protect native animal populations.

Keep your cats indoors at night.

546 million native animals a year are killed by roaming pet cats in Australia.



DOGS

Remember: dogs are not under any circumstances allowed in National Parks.

Dog walking in parks leads to a 35% reduction in bird diversity and 41% reduction in bird abundance.



FEEDING DUCKS

Stop feeding ducks to protect their health.

Angels Wing Syndrome affects waterfowl with insufficient nutrition, hindering them from flying and leading to an early death



STAYING ON PATHS

Stay on designated paths to minimise negative impacts.

Straying off paths increases spreading of weeds, behaviour disturbance, and habitat fragmentation.



WIPING SHOES

Wipe your shoes before going into protected areas to ensure you aren't spreading weeds.

73% of visitors to Australian National Parks carry seeds on their clothes. 288 weed species are carried on humans.

GARDEN WASTE

Dump your garden waste sustainably in the green bin.

70% of plants in gardens are invasive. 45% of natural habitats close to urban areas are affected, disrupting native fauna.
